

1966 Series IIA Stage 3 Land Rover "88" (Defender) -- \$9,500 OBO

This Land Rover has a clear Ohio title, listed as a Series IIA. It has had a Stage 3 update professionally carried out (paper work on the thousands invested by the previous owner included), which means it has the Defender front end with the Rover 3.5 liter V-8 motor and late model 5-speed gearbox. This motor will provide plenty of torque to get out of any off-road situation while also allowing you to easily cruise at 75 mph along the highway.

I've owned this vehicle about 1.5 years now and had intended on carrying out a full restoration but never did. Instead I've used it off-and-on as my daily driver, fixing the couple of things that have broken along the way. As such, this vehicle has a new starter motor, new battery, new clutch slave cylinder, and new tires (about 1000 miles on them).

Options on the vehicle include a second fuel tank, CB radio, full size spare, two folding jump seats in the rear, and a roof rack with tarp that can be setup like an awning/lean-to.

Issues with this Land Rover that will need dealt with sooner or later include sorting out the wiring as it is ugly, fixing windshield wipers (no wiper motor and washer fluid reservoir bad). Very slow leak from secondary/reserve gas tank. Appearance wise you can do as you like; take off the top and doors or completely restore it, the options are pretty wide open in that regard. I have two new doors to include with the truck still in their boxes and a set of good used off road harnesses.

The truck starts and drives great and is fun for bumping around town or getting out into the woods.
